JBL PROFESSIONAL AND PA PLUS SUPPLEMENT TORONTO'S MASSEY HALL WITH MARQUIS SERIES AND CUSTOM SPEAKER TECHNOLOGY

LAS VEGAS, NV, June 8, 2005 — Reinforcing its capacity to supply a supporting sound system made up of the wide ranging installed series and custom designed speakers, JBL Professional announced that it had provided the full range of its speaker technology to PA Plus in Toronto for a system at the renowned Massey Hall.

“We wanted a range of JBL speakers and JBL custom speaker technology,” said Peter Lima, Senior Systems Integrator at PA Plus. “In order to supplement any touring system that comes in, we relied upon our relationship with JBL, their commitment to custom fabrication and their expertise in acoustic modeling and prediction.”

Soon after being built in Toronto in 1892, Massey Hall became internationally famous as Canada's most important venue for concerts and lectures, attracting many of the world's leading celebrities; it also hosted weddings, movies, boxing matches, beauty contests, religious and political rallies, typing contests and chess tournaments. Declared a “heritage” building during the 1970s, Massey Hall remains a vital part of Toronto's cultural and entertainment scene. As such, Massey Hall must have a good in-house supporting sound system for the entire slate of diverse attractions at the venue.

In order to upgrade the in-house sound to fully support any touring system that came to the venue, the consultant, Engineering Harmonics and PA Plus leaned on the expertise of JBL Professional. Comprising the under-balcony system are Marquis Series MS26 two-way systems with dual six-inch woofers to handle the rear balcony fill. JBL's custom UCF2511s were also used for under-balcony support.

The Marquis Series model MS26 is a full-range system designed to provide maximum bandwidth and SPL in a single system package and yet be visually unobtrusive. The enclosure design allows for installation very close to walls and ceilings, thus making it the ideal choice for under balcony, column and wall mounting. The high frequency device is a 1” exit composite diaphragm tweeter integrated to a newly designed elliptical waveguide. The combination exhibits smooth power response resulting in extremely natural voicing. With a nominal 100 x 70-degree coverage pattern, the system provides even coverage for all “fill” type applications.

Ted Leamy, JBL Director of Engineered Sound remarked, " This great installation by PA Plus, requiring special attention to the unique architecture of Massey Hall, is an example of the scalability and versatility of the JBL install family of products."
